

My son Jack is in Woodpecker class, he has a condition called Allen Herndon Dudley Syndrome(MCT8) it impacts all aspects of his development, which has led to global developmental delay. I have two other children who are both in mainstream secondary school. I work part time for a government agency and live with my husband and children near Meersbrook Park.

I have a little girl Gracie-Mae who is in butterfly class. Gracie-Mae was born with a condition called CMV (CYTOMEGALOVIRUS), which affects children with a form of brain damage. It can cause deafness, blindness, non-verbal and unable to mobilise.

Even though Gracie is non-verbal you know exactly what she wants, she is her own little character.

I also have two sons aged 8 and 11 who are in mainstream primary school even though one has ADHD.

I joined this PTA to help the school with different fund raising and to get to know more parents. As we have only just started, we would love more parents to join and support the school and students and get the community to help this lovely school.
